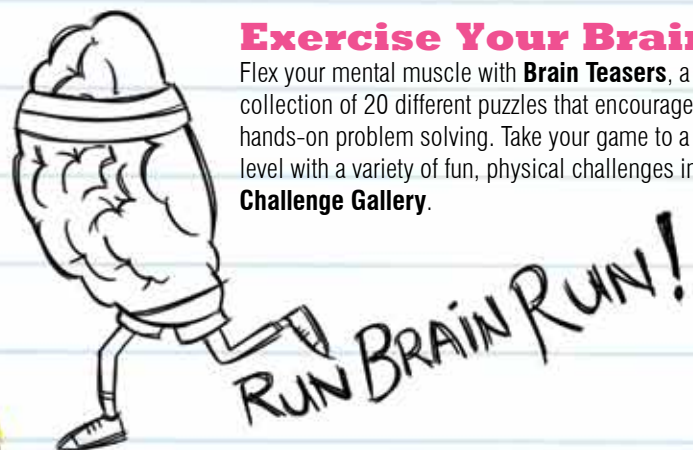

Interactive Science Classes

\$3 per student per class • 60 minutes

Grades PreK-2

- **Busy Bodies:** Learn what it means for your body to be busy by examining the functions of many of your organs.
- **Healthy Habits:** Learn about the role that physical activity and nutrition play in maintaining a healthy heart and body.
- **Squeaky Clean:** Discover how to develop routines that promote good health and good hygiene.

Grades 3-5

- **The Beat Goes On:** Explore the structure and function of the heart and how to keep it healthy.
- **Can You Make Sense of This?:** Use your powers of observation and science tools to study the properties of the newly discovered substance "oobleck."
- **Do You See What I See?:** Take a "look" at the structure, function, and marvels of the eye.

Grades 6-8

Grades 9-12

- **Body of Evidence:** Everyone loves a good murder mystery. Take on the role of a crime lab investigator and see if you can figure out 'whodunit?'

Dissection Demonstrations

Explore the structure and function of organs as you watch an educator-led dissection demonstration! Recommended for Grades 3 and up.

- **The Eye:** Explore the structure and function of the eye and its relationship to the brain during this eye-opening, educator-led cow eye dissection demonstration program. (\$2 per student; 30 minutes)

Siege of the Skeletons

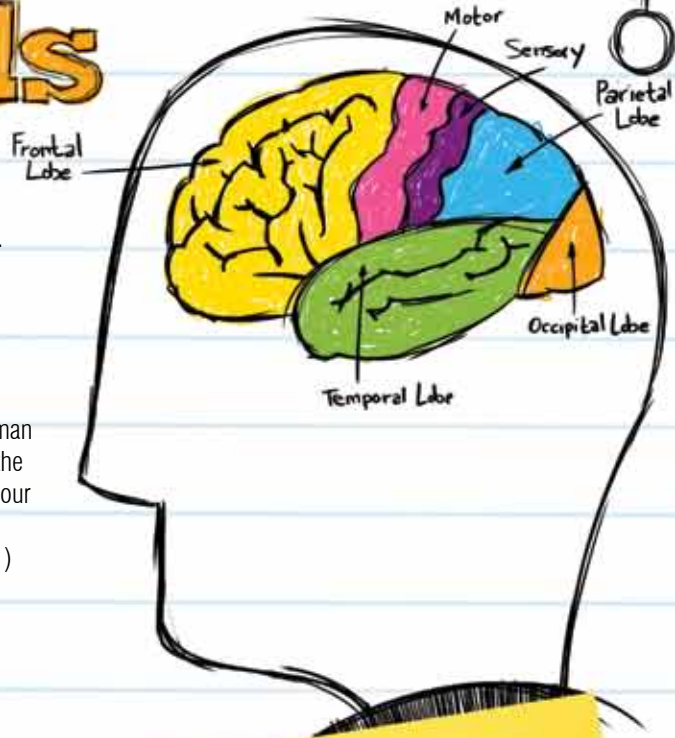
